

Quarantine Process

All watercraft entering Lake Heritage property to use the lake are subject to a 7 day quarantine process if they have been in any other body of water or they are not registered with LHPOA

All other LHPOA registered Boats or watercraft (ie boat out for repair, storage or short term attention.) may enter the lake with a Valid Re-entry Pass.

Boats with no LHPOA registration proof (stickers) must be inspected as required by the LHPOA R&R's, and quarantined.

If quarantine is required, the owner must complete the information section of the Watercraft Quarantine Worksheet. Follow quarantine security procedure below

Quarantine Process

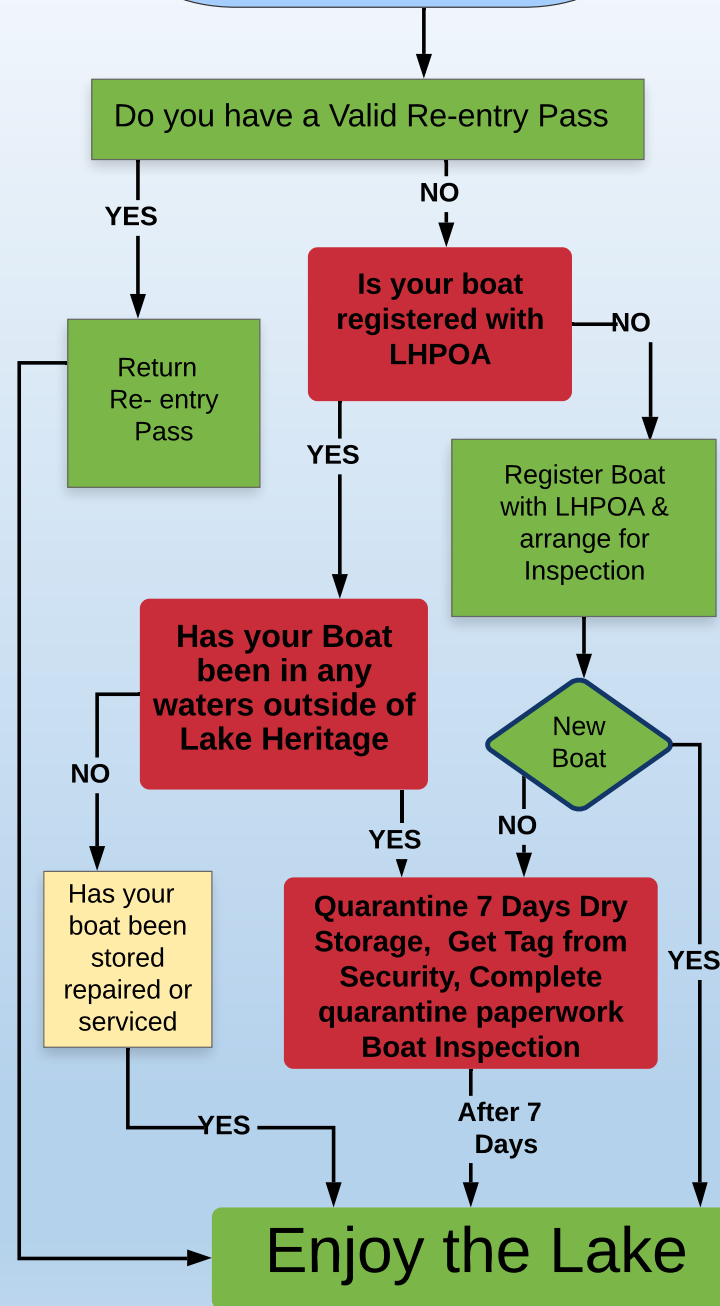
Member is given orange quarantine tag.

The Member secures tag to boat, completes the required paperwork and returns it to security. The Member takes the boat to their residence or boat storage location

The roving security patrol staff will verify the boat is tagged and will pick-up the paperwork if it has not been returned to security

At the end of the 7-day quarantine period, after boat inspection the Member is free to launch their craft into Lake Heritage waters.

Lake Entry Process



Violations of the LHPOA Invasive Species Quarantine Policy is a fine assessment of \$300.00 and a ban of subject watercraft from using Lake Heritage for one year
